Dr. Theresa Koehler, who is an elected Fellow of the American Academy of Microbiology in recognition of her outstanding contributions to the science and profession of microbiology, studies host-pathogen interactions and signaling among the *Bacillus cereus* group species. She is an internationally recognized anthrax expert, and her NIH-funded research program on *Bacillus anthracis* spans more than 30 years.

In her lecture, Dr. Theresa Koehler will focus on the relationship between bacterial physiology and virulence in *Bacillus anthracis*, the causative agent of anthrax.
